VOCATION CORNER

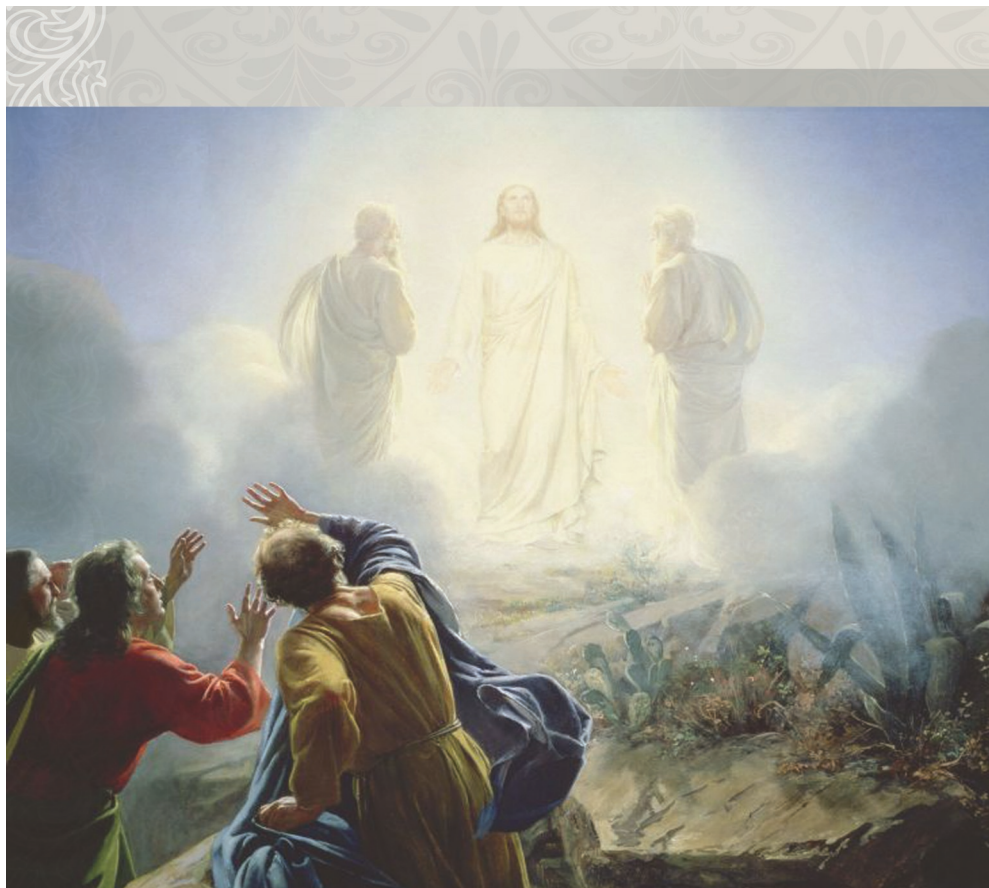
